Amoeba armchair by Verner Panton for Vitra
The core is textured laminate covered with polyurethane foam
The armchair is covered with a red fabric upholstery
The upholstery is removable and can be replaced or put back in place
The Amoeba chair was designed in 1970 in several versions for Verner Panton's famous "Visiona II" installation - a bold living space, psychedelic, futuristic living space that the legendary Danish architect and designer exhibited on a boat at the Cologne Furniture Fair
Amoeba was conceived as a low chaise longue and embodies the free, non-conformist design of the 1960s
The seat and back form a sculptural whole, and the organic form is inspired, as its name suggests, by single-cell organisms. The chair's soft upholstery ensures excellent comfort
