Description

Large glove box in rosewood marquetry and brass fillet inlays, by gantier Preville, located at 50 passage du saumon in Paris. On November 15, 1847, Dominique Louis Rodolphe Lecocq-Preville registered a patent for a type of lace, guipure ... in skins of all kinds. Interesting evidence of the objects that could be sold in Parisian covered passages. A first salmon passage existed in the second third of the 18th century, rebuilt in 1828 and largely demolished in 1899. It now bears the name Passage Ben Aiad.
