### Description

A refined wooden gueridon resting on a tripod base, featuring an elegant hexagonal top with radiating veneer forming a subtle geometric composition. The moulded edge enhances the structure of the top, while the contrast of the veneers creates a delicate play of light. The octagonal shaft is punctuated by an intermediate hexagonal tier, echoing the vocabulary of the upper surface and reinforcing the overall balance of the piece. The tripod base, slightly curved and ending in discreet scroll feet, introduces a sense of movement to an otherwise structured and architectural design. This piece reflects a late 18th-century production, in the spirit of the Louis XVI style, likely made in a provincial context. Dimensions: Height: 77 cm Width: 25 cm
