### Description

Giulio Carpioni, of Venetian origin, found his inspiration in classicism, influenced by Nicolas Poussin, whom he is said to have met early in his career. Bacchanals were a major subject of inspiration for him, recurring very frequently in his work. The use of acid colors and the "expressionist" character of these figures are a way of breaking away from the sometimes overly conventional style of mid-17th-century Italian painting. Most museums, such as the Louvre, have paintings by Carpioni: his originality, his very particular sensibility, all contribute to making him unavoidable.
