This wonderful small painting celebrates the architectural grandeur of Worms Cathedral, built between the 12th and 13th centuries, now known as St. Peter's Cathedral (Dom Sankt Peter in German), one of Germany's most important Romanesque cathedrals. Worms is a city in Rhineland-Palatinate, situated on the west bank of the Rhine. This grand cathedral is admired for its balanced Romanesque architecture, its monumental towers, and the red sandstone typical of the region. The painter depicts this view of the cathedral in a bygone era, with several people in the foreground going about their daily activities.
