Description

Paris porcelain egoiste service decorated by the workshop of Camille Le Tallec. The set adopts an Empire-style form resting on square-section legs fully gilded. It consists of an oval tray, a coffee pot, a covered sugar bowl, a cup and saucer. The decoration features a frieze of roses and foliage treated in grisaille on a sulfur yellow background. Fine gold gilding highlights the handles, pouring spout, and seed-shaped grips. Each piece bears the typical red handwritten mark of the Le Tallec workshop on the reverse, and the codes corresponding to the years of production (in blue). Concerning condition: the coffee pot is in very good condition, a small lack of gilding on the edge of one side of the foot. The sugar bowl is in very good condition, a small lack of gilding on the lower tip of one handle. The cup
