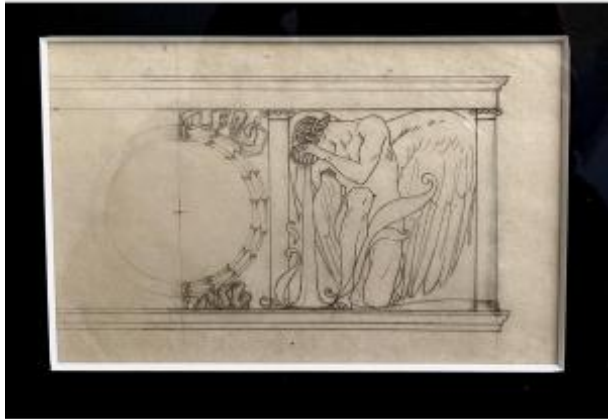




Preparatory Study For A Bas-relief: The Genius Of Mourning

Description

A refined pen drawing depicting a kneeling winged genius, with his head resting on his hands in a gesture of deep mourning. The figure is set within an architectural structure defined by composite columns. On the side, a laurel wreath with ribbons (a symbol of eternal glory) completes the composition, which was likely intended to accommodate an inscription or a medallion. The crisp, academic style suggests the work of a sculptor or architect from the Purist or Neoclassical period. The work evokes the funerary iconography typical of the mid-19th century, inspired by the solemnity of Canova's works and Romantic sensibilities.
