### Description

This very large wrought iron compass is of a journeyman carpenter or stonemason/stonecutter. Intended for taking measurements, tracing curves or marking markers, these tools used by craftsmen were meticulously and carefully crafted. The one we offer has forged tips, the corners are turned down, and the mid-length has a curved and counter-curved motif at mid-length, and the hinges are adorned with an added motif that has unfortunately been amputated of part of its decoration, probably a fleur-de-lys. Length 94 cm.
