The decoration combines geometric and stylized motifs, with alternating turned, guilloché and finely chased registers. The small domed ends are adorned with raised pastilles and stippled decoration, typical of 19th-century folk art productions. This type of object, both utilitarian and demonstrative of the turner's skill, was often made as a virtuoso piece. Very good condition, with a warm, even antique patina.
