Description

Suite of eight Renaissance and Baroque blown crystal roemer glasses (16th - 17th centuries) originally blown in "Waldglas" (fern glass or forest glass) naturally green due to iron oxide impurities, shaped by itinerant glassmakers in the heart of the Rhine forests. The tulip-shaped chalice rests on a ringed truncated cone-shaped leg formed of superimposed circles; the wide foot ensures stability. The small protuberances on the leg are called raspberry pastilles, historically, to ensure a firm grip. Made probably at Theresienthal, the "forest green" roemer is an iconic model of Central European glass culture. Style "Historicism" produced between 1950 and 1980.
