Three-door front with horizontal and vertical wood assembly. The door handles are carved into the wood, and the top and sides are dovetailed.
The interior conceals a large shelf to the left and center, and to the right a storage area with two drawers. The doors close with magnets. French furniture maker from the 60s to the 80s, Maison REGAIN stands for artisanal excellence. Rather than centralize production in a soulless factory, the house had its pieces made in different workshops across France, ensuring it worked with the best cabinetmakers in each specialty. If brand prevailed over ego, one name deserves to be remembered: Roland Haeusler. It was he who designed the majority of those architectural lines, massive yet so gentle, that characterize the
