Description

Black-glazed cup - Southern Italy (Magna Graecia) - 4th-3rd century BC Small black-glazed fired ceramic bowl, featuring a hemispherical profile resting on a low annular foot. The whole piece is covered with a high-quality black slip, now patinated with areas of wear with areas of wear revealing the paste. The piece is fitted with a thick horizontal handle, attached under the lip. This type of production is in the tradition of black-glazed ceramics in southern Italy (Magna Graecia), with links to Campanian and Apulian workshops. By virtue of its morphology and proportions, this bowl belongs to a repertoire of small utilitarian shapes designed for drinking or eating consumption of food and drink at banquets. 10cm diameter 12.7cm with
