Eugenio Pattarino (1885-1971) was an Italian sculptor and ceramist renowned for his monumental religious works in earthenware and terra cotta, often adorned with polychrome and gold. Glazed terra cotta sculpture of the Virgin Mary, made by the Italian artist, Professor Eugenio Pattarino. Signed on the inside of the base (see photo), this statuette measures approximately 40 cm in height and features winged cherub heads floating around her feet. A thumb and a toe are missing - See photos
