An important and
spectacular composition of an animated still life,
Giovanni Crivelli, one of the leading figures in
18th-century Lombard animal painting. The work
fits squarely within the Baroque and late-Baroque
decorative tradition, intended to adorn noble
interiors with subjects of great visual and
symbolic impact. The scene unfolds with a
theatrical arrangement: a group of farmyard
animals--peacocks, turkeys, and roosters--is
arranged in a carefully balanced composition,

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emerging from a dark and atmospheric background. The majestic peacock dominates the composition with its speckled, iridescent tail, flanked by turkeys with vivid red wattles and roosters with brilliant plumage, rendered with extraordinary naturalistic detail. A painting of remarkable quality and substantial size, it represents a significant example of Crivelli's work, likely commissioned by an aristocratic patron and conceived as a decorative element of great prestige.
