Complete samurai armor Japan Edo period (1603-1868) XVIIIth century Iron, lacquer, silk, horsehair, brass Kabuto suji type, tehen chased with a stylized chrysanthemum, hachi featuring eight suji, lacquered leather shikoro with four blades, silk-covered iron mabizashi, green silk agemaki, "mato" (disk)-shaped maedate, kaye-mon (secondary coat of arms) from the A-Bé family of Sa-nuki, Ichi-hashii, Tani; brass kuwagata. Mempo type me no shita men in iron, with horsehair moustache, red lacquered upper lip and gilded teeth; mengu composed of four lacquer slats. Do in two parts decorated with chrysanthemums, takahimo covered in silk. Kote in black silk with tekko and lacquered iron shino. Kusazuri in lacquer, hishinui no ita in silk. Haidate with chikaragawa in patterned beige
