Description

Exceptional Louis XIV period chest of drawers in rosewood and violet wood marquetry...It opens with five drawers, two in the upper section and three in the lower section. Original bronze drawer handles and lingotière. Stamped "Etienne Doirat", cabinetmaker born in Paris in 1675 and died in Paris in 1732. Etienne Doirat was one of the few great cabinetmakers of the Regency to use the stamp. He came from a family of craftsmen who had been working for over a century in the Faubourg "Saint-Antoine". He also worked all his life in the Faubourg, for a wealthy French and foreign clientele. Louis XIV period, very early 18th century (circa 1700 / 1720).
