Attributed to the skills of Karen tribal craftsmen, this drum features intricate tribal decoration and an exceptional finish. It boasts a rich verdigris patina and a conical shape with sturdy side handles for suspension. The round top is adorned with carved frogs, concentric rings and a central sun or star motif.
