Description

Emilian School, 18th century Male nude Oil on canvas, 80 x 32 cm An elegant and refined painting depicting a male nude, created by an artist belonging to the 18th-century Emilian School. The work stands out for its harmonious anatomical rendering and the quality of its drawing, elements that attest to a solid academic training. The figure is posed with classical balance, with particular attention to the study of light that shapes the body and enhances its sculptural volumes. The brushwork is soft and controlled, while the warm, natural color palette evokes the models of great Bolognese painting, influenced by the teachings of the Carracci and their followers. The subject, likely an academic anatomical study, reflects the 18th-century interest in the human body as an ideal of beauty
