Description

This Persian rug from Tabriz, born from the prestigious artisanal tradition of this great city in northwestern Iran, has been renowned for centuries for the finesse and richness of its craftsmanship. Signed by master weaver Pirouzian, it testifies to exceptional skill, where every detail reflects the technical mastery and artistic sensibility characteristic of Tabriz workshops. The design is organized around a sumptuous, richly elaborate central medallion, which unfolds against a deep midnight blue background. This background highlights a profusion of delicate floral motifs, including scrolls, palmettes, and finely drawn arabesques, typical of the classical Tabriz style. The overall structure is highly symmetrical, giving the rug an impression of balance and harmony. The colors,

dominated by warm reds, luminous ivories, and shades of blue, are subtly nuanced and attest to the high quality of the dyeing process. The particularly rich main border elegantly frames the central field. It is adorned with stylized and repetitive floral motifs, creating a visual framework that enhances the depth of the design. The thinner counter-borders add further refinement by precisely highlighting the overall effect. This rug thus embodies the tradition of large Tabriz rugs, where the influence of classic Persian designs blends with exceptionally fine workmanship, often achieved with tight knots that allow for outstanding definition of the motifs. Dimensions: 350 x 260 cm Condition: This rug shows significant overall wear, with marked wear to the fringes and border on one side. There is also a break in the fringes of approximately 15 cm, clearly visible in the photo, attesting to its history and authenticity.*Video available upon request
