The original statue, produced in the first half of the 15th century and formerly housed in the city's cathedral, enjoyed great renown. It gave rise to an abundant production of statuettes, figurines and sconces for pilgrims. Our example faithfully reproduces the typical characteristics of this model: elegant posture of the Virgin, rhythmic treatment of the drapery, high crown and architectural base. These
