DECOR Round plate made of siliceous earthenware with a polychrome decoration under a lead-glaze. The center features a radiating floral composition arranged around a large central Saz leaf. The decoration features tulip stems and carnation flowers rendered primarily in tomato red, cobalt blue, emerald green, and black. The rim is adorned with a wide border featuring a "waves and rocks" motif with black scrolls and blue highlights. The reverse side features a simplified decoration of blue and green floral medallions. Ottoman Art, Turkey, 17th century
Condition: No major cracks or previous restoration, and the glaze retains a beautiful luster across the entire piece. There are areas of chipped
