Description

The Lucano bridge, dating from the 1st century BC, is a Roman bridge over the river Anio, located in the province of Rome, Italy, on via Tiburtina. In the background, an imposing round tower (the mausoleum of the Plautii) is seen from the shore, where a shepherd with his dog watches over his flock of sheep and cows, while a horseman and peasants cross the bridge. And The Æmilius or Palatine bridge or ponte Rotto (the broken bridge) is Rome's oldest stone bridge over the Tiber.
