A refined mid-18th-century Louis XV-style panel from Naples, circular in shape, made of gilded copper and finely embossed, depicting the Virgin Mary with the Infant Jesus and the infant Saint John, a typical expression of 18th-century Marian devotion. The composition is distinguished by the elegance of the figures and the gentleness of their faces, framed by radiant halos, a symbol of holiness. The scene is set within a fine contemporary frame of carved and gilded wood in the Louis XV style, made in Naples, adorned with floral motifs and rosettes at the corners, featuring a richly sculpted cornice and central pendant.
