### Description

A magnificent example of French Art Deco craftsmanship, this large console table from the 1920s perfectly illustrates the movement's attachment to geometry, luxurious materials and meticulous craftsmanship. Its tapered architectural form is richly adorned with wood marquetry, whose veneers, arranged in a rhythmic, symmetrical pattern, catch the light and emphasize the console's sculptural silhouette. The play of warm tones and the precision of the inlay work reflect the refined elegance that characterized French decorative arts in the early 20th century. Generous proportions give it a strong visual presence, making it an ideal centerpiece for an entrance hall, living room or art gallery-worthy interior. Despite its age, the console is remarkably well preserved, showing

only a few traces of use, subtle marks that testify to its history without altering its refinement.
