Jeurat / p. 1776" Very good condition Old refinishing (1927) Very fine frame, restoration period Our painting recalls a very similar composition by Etienne Jeurat, "Les Chartreux en méditation", which he exhibited at the Salon of 1759 and which is now conserved in the church of Saint Bernard de la Chapelle in Paris (close subject treated as a landscape with similar types of figures and elements that can be found directly, such as the architecture with cutaway panels, and plants with large leaves). The subject here of the Temptation of Saint Anthony brings an added charm: the Saint is tempted by the Devil, who presents him with a young girl,
