### Description

Germaine Bouret, Paris 1907 - 1953 French illustrator, shematic series: small trades, festivals, religious subjects, sea bathing, winter sports, hunting, etc. Her designs are widely used by retailers: boxes, packaging, calendars, books, discs..., as well as in advertising (Nestlé, Blédina...). One million of her drawings were distributed worldwide. She takes part in fairs and at the Universal Exhibition of 1937 in the Arts and Techniques category. She briefly contributes to the magazine Jean-Pierre. Germaine Bouret found inspiration in the streets and squares, drawing children, the almost exclusive theme of her work. Her work and life are closely linked to her twin brother, Marcel Bouret, who wrote all the captions for his drawings. "Portrait
