Charming oil on canvas marouflaged on strong cardboard depicting a traditional Central European festival scene. The work features a group of women and children dressed in richly colored folk costumes, in a warm, lively atmosphere. The vivid hues and dynamic composition bring a great deal of life and character to the whole. The style, both narrative and decorative, evokes the work of Central European artists, particularly the twentieth-century Czech school, where rural scenes and folk traditions feature prominently. The work is unsigned on the front, but a name is visible on the back (to be studied), suggesting a possible attribution: Jaroslav Zak
