This piece of furniture is not only functional but represents a true work of cabinetmaking and folk sculpture. Material: High-quality solid oak. Period: Late 18th century (approx. 1780-1800). Features: The structure rests on four carved truncated pyramid-shaped legs. The central body is defined by panels featuring rich and complex figurative bas-reliefs that likely depict religious, allegorical, or rural life scenes, typical of the folk art of the period. The upper section features a slanted drop-down top (or with upper doors) that traditionally served as a storage unit for bread or

The two iron (or dark wood) rings on the front complete the sturdy and elegant design. o
