Description

Porcelain flower pot, Jacob Petit (1796-1868), 19th century
Elegant and rare polychrome porcelain bouquetière, attributed to the manufacture of Jacob Petit, emblematic of 19th-century Parisian production. This piece is distinguished by its particularly decorative tripartite form, composed of four corollas designed to hold flowers, arranged around a central baluster body. The whole rests on a moving scrolled base, typical of the rocaille taste revisited in the 19th century. The rich decoration combines a deep black background enhanced by finely executed gilded ornamentation with scrolls, foliage and arabesque motifs in the orientalist taste, a stylistic signature characteristic of Jacob Petit. Relief elements, treated in white, violet and blue, provide a particularly elegant contrast,

while gold highlights finely emphasize volumes and carved details. The quality of execution, vivid polychromy and bold decorative vocabulary fully inscribe this piece in the sought-after aesthetic of Jacob Petit's productions, highly prized for their originality and whimsy.
