## Antique Persian Kashan Mortachem Wool Kork Rug - Late 19th Century

### Description

Persian rug, attributed to the Kashan Mortachem workshop, dating from the late 19th century. Made from lambskin kork wool, renowned for its finesse and quality, it rests on a cotton structure (warp, weft and bangs). The decoration features an ivory field adorned with delicate floral motifs in pastel shades, sublimated by a central blue medallion. The whole is framed by a midnight-blue main border embellished with ivory motifs, offering a harmonious and refined contrast. The knotting density, estimated at between 9,000 and 9,500 knots per dm<sup>2</sup>, testifies to precise and meticulous work. Dimensions: Length: 203 cm Width: 132.5 cm
