Pair of ornamental vases in Paris porcelain, France, Empire period Restoration - early 19th century circa 1820. Beautiful, humorous decoration, telling a story in 2 stages: that of a putti unhooking a bird's nest, to count the eggs, in matte and glossy gilded frames and decoration on a crimson background decorated with gryphons. The side handles are swan-necked. Superb matte and bright gold gilding. Beautiful large-format vases; the depth of color makes them highly decorative. Ideal for adorning a mantelpiece or chest of drawers, to complement a pair of candlesticks in an Empire decor. Excellent overall condition, extremely fresh gilding with no wear, no accidents or broken parts glued back (except for a missing swan's beak tip).
