Large gouache by E. Spinosa, Neapolitan painter. Neapolitan painter of the mid-19th century. This beautiful panorama offers a classic, luminous perspective of Italy's Sorrento coast. In the background of the composition, the town of Sorrento, which stretches along the cliffs in the Bay of Naples. We see white buildings with tiled roofs, nestled in dense, green vegetation and orange groves. In the background, the Bay of Naples opens out onto a Mediterranean blue sea. In the background, the mountains of the Sorrento peninsula in mauve and pink tones, characteristic of the Mediterranean light at the end of the day. dominated by warm pastel tones. The sky fades from azure blue to a pale pink near the horizon. The contrasts between the ochre of the stone and the deep green of the vegetation create a sensation of relief and life. This is a typical of the "Grand Tour" style, brought back by European travelers to Italy.
