Trained at the École Nationale Supérieure des Beaux-Arts in Paris between 1945 and 1952 on a French government scholarship, he developed a solid technical mastery and a personal artistic language there, which won him several awards. In the United States, he worked as a sculptor for a number of years. Insettled in San Francisco in 1953, he pursued an active career as a sculptor and teacher, exhibiting throughout California and the United States. His work was notably the subject of a solo exhibition at the De Young Museum in 1960. He
