Japanese hand-painted porcelain Imari oval dish, 1920s
Superb Japanese Imari porcelain oval dish, dating from the 1920s, hand-decorated in the traditional Imari palette blending cobalt blue, iron red and warm orange hues. This piece features an elegant and dynamic composition of stylized floral motifs and traditional ornaments, highlighted by a beautiful oval shape with a slightly scalloped outline. The reverse bears an original Japanese mark, confirming its authenticity and provenance. Oval Imari dishes are particularly sought-after for their sculptural presence and versatility, able to be used both as serving pieces and decorative display objects. Through the strength of its colors and the balance of its decoration, this example is a fine testimony to Japanese porcelain craftsmanship of the early
