Oil on panel, tavern scene, 17th-century Flemish school The composition and subject are in the tradition of genre paintings depicting "petite vie" These representations of everyday life, where people are seen drinking and socializing in taverns, were a popular theme in Dutch and Flemish art of the period In this work, we see men, women and even a child in a tavern Some people in the background are preparing to descend a staircase, creating an impression of depth Aside, we see a violinist and probably other musicians at his side. In the foreground, we see a man drinking and a woman dancing Other people to their left and right complete the scene The accurate depiction of rustic interiors, wooden beams and various ceramic vessels completes the scene The use of ochre tones and colored accents
