Beautiful Japanese Imari porcelain plate from the 1920s, featuring an elegant scalloped rim, a detail particularly prized by Imari collectors. Hand-painted in traditional shades of cobalt blue, iron red and gold highlights, this plate displays a classic decoration of floral motifs arranged in reserves, around a finely ornamented central medallion. The richness of the composition and the intensity of the palette illustrate with refinement the craftsmanship of early 20th-century Japanese porcelain. The reverse features delicate underglaze blue decoration, confirming its hand-painted execution. With its sculptural shape and handsome diameter, this piece makes an ideal presentation plate for a wall hanging, a shelf or a
