Description

piatto in maiolica italiana di Montelupo, databile alla prima metà del XVII secolo (circa 1620-1640). The lightly concave shape with rounded edge and rounded base presents a decorative polychrome pattern typical of the Montelupo production, one of the most important Italian ceramic centers in the first century. It is decorated, interamente dipinto a mano, è centered on a figura di alabardiere in movement, inserted in a stylized piece with architectural and vegetable elements. The composition, vivacious and narrative, reveals a noteworthy pictorial quality and a taste for the figurative scene particularly appreciated in the collection. The color range, dominated by intense colors, green and blue manganese, is typical of this product and gives the floor a strong decorative presence.
