Description

Slightly flared engraved crystal glass with Masonic decoration. The body is adorned with rich wheel-engraved motifs, combining symbols and decorative elements characteristic of Masonic iconography. The center features a six-pointed star framing a radiating motif, probably a symbolic evocation of light or knowledge. The whole is surrounded by a wreath of foliage, reinforcing the initiatory and symbolic dimension of the composition. On another side, a stylized architectural motif, evoking columns or buildings, completes the ornamentation. The upper part is highlighted by a geometric frieze, while latticework and arcature motifs give structure to the overall decoration. This type of glass is often
