Description

This exceptional and atmospheric seascape was painted in oil on canvas in the early 20th century by the renowned Swedish artist Astrid Wahlstedt (1877 - 1946). The canvas captures a serene day in a sea harbour, where almost decorative clouds float slowly across a clear sky, their outlines reflecting on the sea surface and whimsically merging with the contours of the waves. Against the horizon, the contrasting silhouettes of sailing boats with bright sails filled by a light sea breeze take on a special expressiveness. A brilliant compositional solution and masterful use of textured brushwork allow the artist to achieve the illusion of a living mise-en-scène. This painting leaves a wonderful sense of peace and space, breathing the romance of northern nature, and will become a magnificent decoration for any
