Description

This vase of exceptional proportions (nearly 80 cm in height) is highly representative of late 20th-century architectural ceramics. Crafted from porcelain, the structural design relies on a generous ovoid body extending into a very long, slender cylindrical neck, terminating in a widely flared, flat corolla-like lip. The entire piece is covered in a monochrome black glaze of absolute brilliance. This surface treatment, acting as a dark mirror, emphasizes the rigor of the lines and the total absence of superfluous ornamentation. Aligning with the minimalist design movement of the 1970s and 1980s, this piece illustrates the desire of European manufactories to design objects of spectacular dimensions, intended to structure space rather than serve a merely utilitarian purpose. lacquered black and a highly elongated profile calls to mind the radical elegance of Italian design or post-modern productions of the era, where the object transcends its function to become a true autonomous sculpture. Condition report: Excellent condition. The glaze presents an even shine and shows no structural defects.

Through its scale and highly graphic profile, this vase will stand out as a decorative centerpiece. It will authoritatively anchor an entryway, a corner of a contemporary living room, or a hallway, displayed bare as a sculpture or adorned with tall, sleek branches.
