Here are the 2 large panels that faced each other. Exquisitely fine workmanship. Do not be mistaken, this pair represents the greatest refinement in weaving as well as in finesse of execution. The motif composed of series of stylized flowers in successive oblique bands is very rare. True collector's items, we will particularly appreciate here the presence of a pair and an irreproachable condition. Technique : Sumak Wool on wool. Vegetal hues of unprecedented freshness.
