Description

Oil on canvas painting depicting the Annunciation, an Italian work dating from the late 17th century. The composition shows the Virgin Mary at the moment of the announcement, kneeling beside a lectern with an open book, while the Archangel Gabriel enters the scene with a solemn gesture holding a lily, symbol of purity. The dove of the Holy Spirit appears above, according to traditional iconography. The composition is characterized by a strong use of chiaroscuro, with a marked contrast between the darker area and the luminous opening illuminating the figures, a typical feature of late 17th-century Italian painting. The draperies are rendered in warm and deep tones, with particular attention to reds and ochres. The painting shows signs of age, with oxidized varnish and scattered
