Description

A beautiful gilded bronze disc brooch from the 10th to the 11th century A.D. with seven radiating lobes or legs to the rim; each handle with a blue, black and white enamel insert (one partly remaining and one missing); main body divided into six, all filled with filled with blue and green enamel. The cloisonné technique uses compartments constructed from wire then filled with colored powdered "glass" and fired. Diameter: 25 mm. Condition: see photos. Iron pin missing. Weetch type 20. A Search location: Norfolk
