Important 18th-century Flanders tapestry with richly composed greenery, typical of Flemish productions of this period. This type of tapestry is characterized by an abundance of vegetation (trees, foliage, undergrowth) animated by scenes and characters. In the foreground, an elegant female figure dressed in antique style stands in a wooded landscape, accompanied by animal and plant elements. The background opens onto a lacustrian perspective with architecture, bringing depth and poetry to the composition. A magnificent upper border is adorned with floral and fruit garlands, in the decorative taste of the 18th century, recalling Flemish productions blending nature and decorative ornamentation. Beautiful harmony of colors in soft, weathered tones, with greens and blues
