Description

Pair of cabriolet bergères with violonné backs in waxed beech. The upper crosspiece carved with flowers, the upholstered armrests rest on molded curved consoles. The scrolled, molded crosspieces are joined by cambered feet decorated with flowers, the front crosspiece is also carved with flowers. Parisian work from the Louis XV period. They are stamped below the front crosspieces J . LECHARTIER. LECHARTIER (Jacques), furniture joiner, born in 1754, died in Paris on March 22, 1809. He won his master's degree on September 9, 1773. They are reupholstered in new horsehair with reversible feather-filled cushions.
