Oil on canvas depicting Monsignor Buonamente Augustini; Date: 17th century; Painted by Jacob Ferdinand Voet (Antwerp, 1639-Paris, 1689) A Flemish painter of the Baroque period, he developed his career in Rome during the second half of the 17th century, combining Flemish craftsmanship with the Italian and French Baroque styles. He became famous for painting portraits at the papal court and among the Roman aristocracy. Among his most important patrons was Queen Christina of Sweden, portrayed here with her friends.
