The set is entirely handcrafted. The set is made entirely in platinum, with precise, regular setting work typical of the quality jewelry of the interwar period. The diamonds, all old-cut, bring a soft, lively brilliance, in perfect harmony with the pearl's satin luster. The composition is punctuated by a succession of diamonds of different calibers, organized in gradation around
