Extraordinary Khorjin Bathiyari from Persia. Many aspects are worthy of note. The size, this compact 102 x 90 cm format is totally surprising. Usually, this type of piece is found in more modest dimensions, around 50 x 60 cm. The mixed technique, with the lower part of around 30 cm in knotted stitch and the other surface in Sumak technique. The motifs, with the presence of dragons in their fenced-in cage. The shades, beautifully soft and in perfect harmony. The state of preservation, irreproachable, verging on the miraculous. Khorjin are wonderful everyday objects once used by nomadic populations throughout Persia. The Sumak technique is similar to embroidery. It requires the use of a second weft thread to create all the surface motifs. From the amateur or collector's point of view, this
