A rare beauty, an elegant and refined Shahsaven kilim from Persia. The work is considerable, with the entire surface of the piece embroidered. The weaver uses a second weft thread to create the raised motifs. As you can see from the photos, this piece is made up of 2 panels joined and sewn together. This is a distinctive feature of ancient pieces, as the formerly nomadic populations only had small, easily transportable looms at their disposal. At one end, the bangs are remarkable, woven into a fishnet. Beauty is often hidden in the details. Exclusively plant-based hues of unparalleled freshness. The object is simply ravishing.
