Description

Oil on oak panel
Attributed to Willem van Diest by the Turquin appraisal firm
Elegant 17th-century Dutch marine depicting several vessels sailing under the flag of the United Provinces in a peaceful sea. In the foreground, an imposing vessel seen from the stern displays all the painter's virtuosity in rendering rigging, sails and naval framework details. In the background, other ships animate the horizon in a subtle atmospheric perspective. The work is attributed to Willem van Diest, a specialist in night seascapes and harbor scenes, active in The Hague in the mid-17th century. Heir to the tradition of Jan Porcellis and the first great Dutch marine painters, Van Diest developed a refined style of painting, particularly appreciated for the precision of his ships and the luminous quality of his

skies. This composition is particularly captivating for its remarkable technical mastery: - exceptional finesse in the drawing of masts and ropes, - meticulous rendering of the floating flags, - subtle atmospheric treatment of marine light, - delicate tonal variations in water reflections, - depth achieved through skilful construction of successive shots. The oak panel, made up of two old boards, features old preparation and inscriptions on the reverse. The quality of the support and the precision of execution testify to particularly meticulous workshop work. A very fine cabinet work, typical of Dutch Golden Age painting, combining decorative quality and historical interest in 17th-century maritime art.
